Carer Break Vouchers

Surrey County Council have introduced Carer Break Vouchers which is a simple and flexible way to provide some short term breaks. The Voucher scheme has been designed to offer carers flexibility in the timing of a break and a choice in how alternative care can be provided while you take a break from your caring role.

Who will provide the care when you take a break?

The vouchers are for use with registered care providers which could be Residential or Nursing Homes, Day Centres, Homecare, or voluntary organisations such as Crossroads.

You are able to choose from a list of providers which is growing all the time. If you find a good registered provider which is not on the list your Social Worker or Care Manager may be able to arrange for their details to be included by contacting the relevant Carers Development Officer.

How do you use the vouchers?

Once you have received your vouchers use this list of approved providers, to select a provider for a short term break. Contact the provider with suitable dates etc. Once your short term break is due to begin sign the appropriate vouchers where indicated. The provider of the service you selected



will then do the rest of the work to redeem the voucher.

Vouchers are valued at £10, £20 and £50. All vouchers have an expiry date on them. However if you do not use the voucher by the expiry date contact your Social Worker or Care Manager as soon as possible. If you have any questions regarding Care Break Voucher call the Contact Centre on 08456 009009
