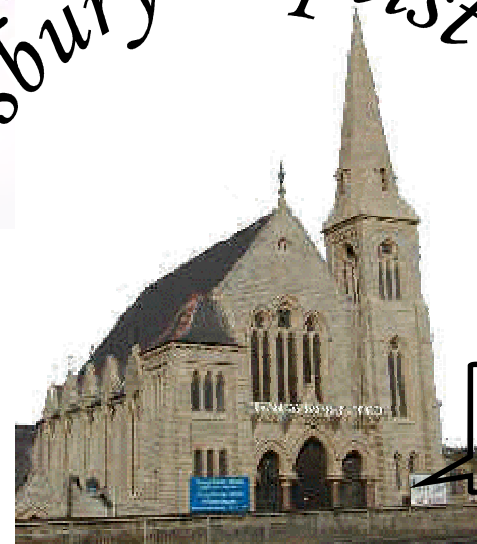

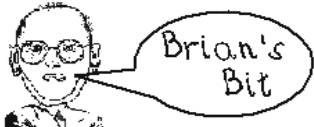

So the year, speeding on its way, has brought us round again to Remembrance Sunday – this year it's not very long before the start of Advent. Remembrance

has been observed in many different ways in my experience – there was even a time when I thought naïvely that it would have much less importance as the years went by and even die out. I couldn't really have got it more wrong! All through my life, Remembrance Day has gained in importance. In recent years, the ceremony on November 11th, which had at one time been moved to the nearest Sunday, has been reintroduced on the day itself. And of course it never has been just about the two World Wars. The dead and injured of many other conflicts have quite rightly taken their place in our thoughts and our services. Still, for us, the main thrust of the service is always the same: we remember those who gave their lives with affection and thanksgiving; we reflect on the horrors of war and pray for peace; and we commit ourselves to do whatever is within our power to make our world, our country and our community a better place for children to grow up and for all to live. So today we will follow the time-honoured practice of hearing the roll of honour read out, this time by a young man of the same age as many who died, and we will be encouraged to renew our determination to pray and work for peace in every way we can.

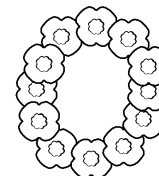
Brian has received a message from the African Pastor for whom he translated:
