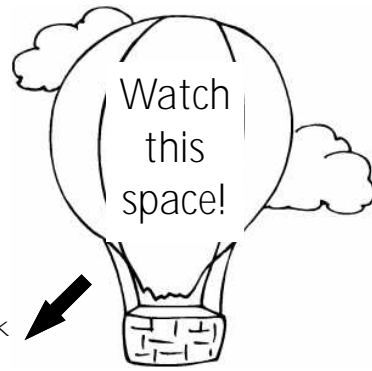

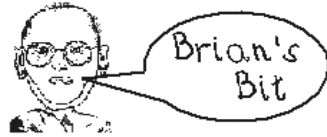

It is a great joy to welcome Tony Taylor to our
service this morning. Tony and Rosemary
moved several years ago from their home in
Skipton, where Tony was Minister of Earby and
Salterforth Baptist Churches, and also an
insurance agent, to Idle, Bradford, where I
lived more than 50 years ago. Some years
before Tony came to be Minister, the Church at
Idle had demolished its huge Victorian chapel
and used some of the original stone to replace
it with a new Church and Community Centre
building. There are still those in the church who
have not found this change easy, but with
Tony's patient, caring ministry it seems to me
that the whole community is now moving
forward together in a very positive way. On
most days, the Community Centre is buzzing
with activity, ranging from meals for senior
citizens to table tennis and weight watchers.
There's even occasionally a breakfast for local
ministers, prepared by Tony very early in the
morning. Although there is no Sunday School,
there is a monthly children's event on a
Saturday: "Live Wires", which attracts good
numbers. Altogether it's an interesting venture
in outreach to the community, seeking at the
same time to enable the church members, some
of whom are quite elderly, to feel involved.
Tony comes to share in our worship this
morning and remind us that we belong to a
fellowship of 110 or so churches spread across
much of Yorkshire (and a bit of Derbyshire).
We hope that his visit to Dewsbury will be an
encouragement to him, as well as to us.
