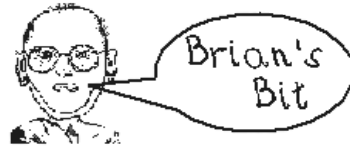

We're making a start on the necessary maintenance programme for our historic building. Some time ago an extensive survey was done, involving photos of the roof taken from a "cherry picker" and other detailed investigations. This has culminated in an action plan of things that need to be done, arranged in descending order of urgency and prepared for us by Russel Trudgen of Arctic Associates. The good news is that the building is in remarkably good condition for a 140 year-old, and in that we rejoice. Nevertheless, there is work to be undertaken, much of which is quite simple though, of course, at a great height, requiring scaffolding or possibly the return of the famous cherry picker, and inevitably a certain degree of cost. The Grant Committee, which met last Wednesday, is looking into the possibilities for raising money to cover this work. We would ask everyone first of all to make this a matter of prayer: that this building in its strategic location might continue to serve God's purpose and be well maintained for many years to come. We would also ask you to think positively and creatively about the subject. All ideas, suggestions and questions will be welcome – you can bring them to me or any of the Deacons and we will be encouraged by your interest. The building is not just there to keep the rain off while we preach the gospel. It also makes a clear statement to all who pass by, just by being there. It is our intention that it should continue to do so for many years to come.
