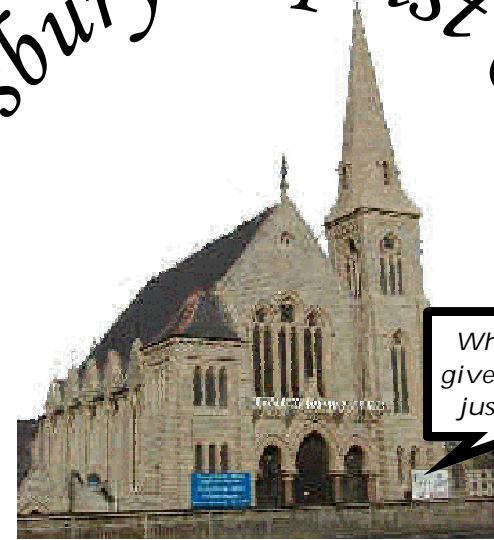

at the YBA Executive over the last year or so about our new strategy for association life. I've witnessed the ideas coming together, first of all for the theme of "Confidence" and then the task of identifying the four strands: evangelism, discipleship, leadership and spirituality. Then came the next bit, the sending out of messengers to all the 110 churches of the YBA. The plan was to prepare and send out seventy messengers in twos, modelled of course on the pattern Jesus used with his disciples. As it has turned out, there aren't quite seventy, although a substantial number of church members are involved, ministers and others. Not all the churches are participating, but a considerable majority are. On Thursday May 19th, all the messengers will have the opportunity to meet together, report back and compare notes. So, for us the day has finally come and we welcome Glenn Cannon, from Scapegoat Hill, Huddersfield and Vic Garfitt, from Maltby, Rotherham. By what seems to be just a coincidence, as you read this I will be visiting Vic's church in Maltby with Mary Taylor, from Wakefield, as part of the same process. I hope you'll all enjoy the service and gain a real understanding of what the strategy is about. A lot of planning and preparation has gone into it, and there's much more to follow. Like many things in church life, it will be true that the more we put into it, the more we will be likely to get out. I think that if we seriously take it to heart, there's a strong likelihood that the YBA and its churches will never be the same again.
