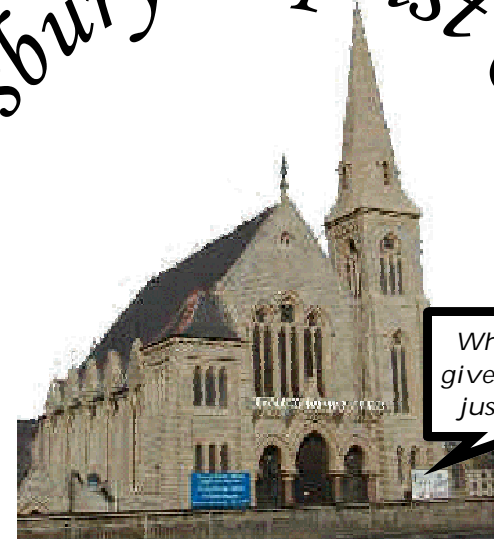

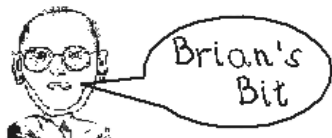

I hope again that the things we share as a church will help all of us to draw closer to our Saviour as we follow and reflect on his cross and resurrection.
