As for Sunday mornings, after a quick look back over the "Ten" series next week, with "Christ the Fulfilment of the Law", our theme will be "Jesus – God the Man", taking a broad look at the life of Christ from infancy right through to crucifixion and resurrection. The method is my usual one, technically known as Biblical Exposition. It involves taking a Bible passage, studying it carefully and speaking about it in a way that is hopefully helpful to all concerned. This is not the only way to do things in church, but it's generally been my practice and I imagine it's the one most of us are accustomed to. Of course, over the years, I've looked at various other ways but never found them to be more satisfactory. I do get rather excited at the thought of getting into a series of studies based on a part of scripture that I know and love, with the opportunity to spend quite a lot of time reflecting, preparing and finally preaching it. I value feedback, when it's positive and constructive and I would especially ask everyone to pray with me that this activity might achieve something for God in all of our lives – that the Winter and Spring of 2011 might turn out to be a blessing for every one of us.

Glen Kilduff has been in hospital this week. He is hoping to have an operation this coming week. Please keep him in your prayers

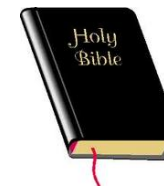
