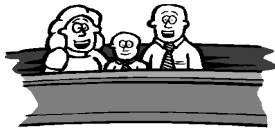

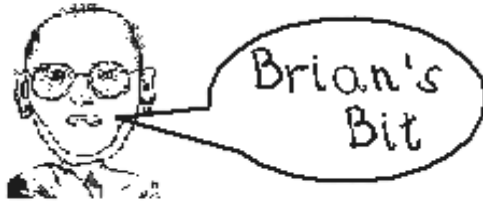

Before Easter we had a visit from Glenn Cannon and Vic Garfitt on behalf of the YBA, presenting the new strategy entitled "Our Confidence Together in Christ". It wouldn't be the first time that most of you had heard the subject mentioned. Now, for the period between Easter and Pentecost, I'm planning to take some more time on Sunday mornings to develop the subject and explain what it is about, as I understand it. As always in worship, my aim will be to ground the whole thing in the Bible and look for what God may be saying to us through it. The four sub-headings of the strategy are Confident Discipleship, Spirituality, Leadership and Evangelism. They are intended to be taken in any order, so I've arranged them in a way which seems to me to fit together with the other things planned for this time. Right in the middle of the series, we will be having a visit from the YBA President, Rev. Tony Taylor, who will probably give us his own perspective on this part of Association life.

Our theme for today is Confident Discipleship. It's a theme that could be developed at great length, covering a whole series of sermons and Bible studies. In fact, you could really say that discipleship is the sum total of everything we speak about and do as Christians. So how I'm going to pack all that into one service is a bit of a mystery. We'll just have to see how it turns out. One thing is certain: this is not just something to talk about, or even sing and pray about. Discipleship is above all something to be

lived out in the daily reality of our lives. That's what I want to make clear more than anything else.

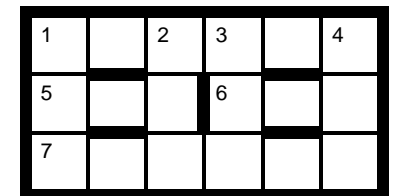
