

News from Chitra Karki, mission partner in Nepal

It was good to welcome back Chitra Karki from Nepal to the morning service on 22nd April. Chitra is the Assistant Pastor of the New Life Church. He is also involved in several other projects like building a school in his own village.

Chitra shared with us that he was thrown out of his village for being a Christian. Now many in his village have become Christians after his aunt was miraculously healed. The walls of the school have been built but they needed more money to

put on a roof. This has to be done as soon as possible because June is the start

of the rainy season. If the roof is not on by then the walls will crumble. I am pleased to report that after the House Group meeting Chitra had the money to

build the roof! Dollar Parish Church is supporting the Grace Children Home that Chitra set up some years ago. There are 10 orphaned children living with Chitra

and his family at the moment but he would like to expand the church accommodation to include a place for the children enabling them to take more orphans. There are many homeless children wandering about the streets of Kathmandu and the Church would like to help some of them. Chitra also sang

and involved the congregation too. He has made a CD of tunes he has composed

After the Prayer Meeting Chitra was given a digital camera which will let him send us photos of the work he is involved in. Chitra is much blessed by our support both financially and in prayer. He has been greatly encouraged by his visit with us here in Dollar. Please remember him and his
