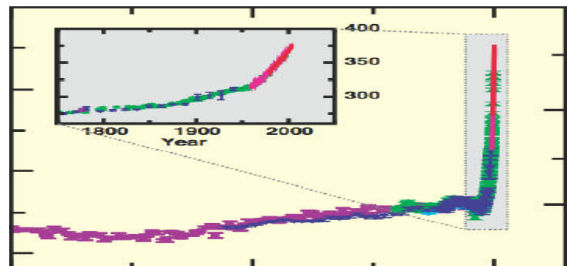

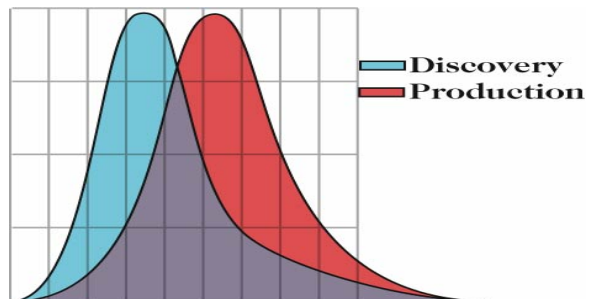
2. This graph shows global change over the last 10,000 years. What was measured?

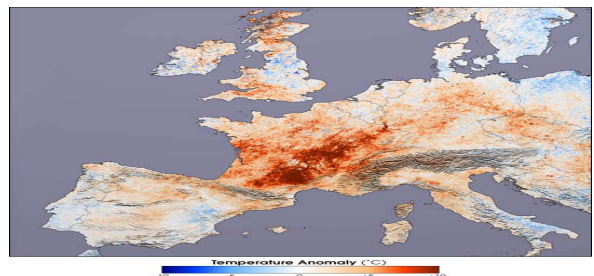
