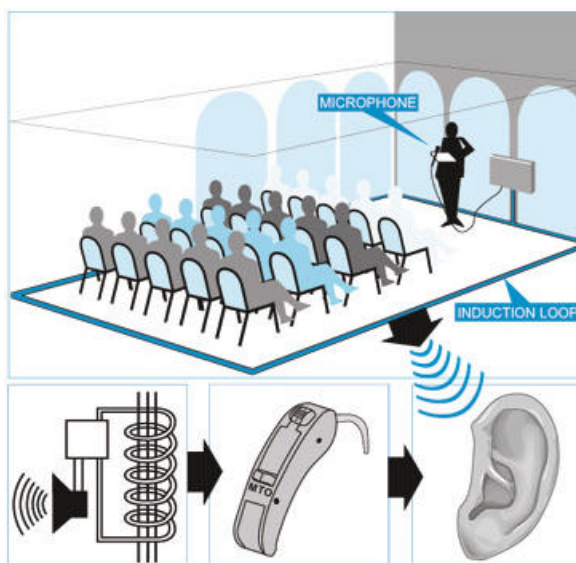


KTP ROOM INDUCTION LOOP SYSTEM
