NOTICE OF RACE
2012 PERISHER SERIES

Two back-to-back races with 'gate starts' will be run on nine Sundays, commencing on **Sunday 5th February till Sunday 1st April** making 18 races in all. The first start will commence at 10.45 am.

Please note that the Laser Fleet of Parkstone Yacht Club runs the Perisher race series **and therefore all correspondence and queries are to be through the Laser Fleet Captain.**

The racing is keen, but the accent is on friendly competition with post-race socialising in the comfort of the Club lounge. Last year 16 races were run, with best turnout 25 and an average of 20 boats with total competitors of 31 entered, 27 for the whole series.

COMMITTEE BOAT - VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR OOD AND ASSISTANT

A duty list will be put on the Laser notice board so please add your names for the subsequent races.

Ideally, we need a volunteer willing to drive the Committee Boat for the majority of the series (sitting in the Committee Boat of a crisp Sunday morning, watching the Lasers battling it out with each other and the elements, is much more fun than lounging in bed; you can even bring your teddy). This will leave us needing only one crew per week. Whatever the situation, please add your name to the roster as appropriate. As in recent years I do hope to get people not racing in the series to cover this.

SAFETY

Since the normal Club Rescue facilities will not be available, it is every competitor's responsibility to look out for anyone in difficulty and go to their aid if required. Redress will be given to any competitors assisting others.

BOAT STORAGE

Boat storage will be available for sailors competing in at least 50% of the series. (It was noted that during the winter series this was not complied with by all.) We are being allocated up to 20 spaces and the cost will be half summer storage fee, (£35.00). The Laser Fleet Captain or his deputy will allocate spaces and the fee will be taken at time of entry to the series. (The Class Captain pays the storage fee to the club as all administration is carried out within the class). Please annotate entry form if space required.

ENTERING

All there that is left to do is enter now and give yourself a mid-winter treat. Fill in the attached entry form and get it to me with your cheque as soon as possible.
