Tea-Time Church

What is Tea-Time Church?

St John's has been running a Junior or Tea-Time Church once a month since March 2010. It is based loosely on the "Messy Church" concept. It's a great opportunity for busy families to take some time out to worship together in church and have fun at the same time!

Who is it for?

Children at primary school with their parents / carers and siblings.

When is it?

The first Thursday of the month (except August). You can arrive between 3.30pm and 4pm; we end at about 5.45pm.

What happens?

Tea-Time Church is led by a team of volunteers from St John's, together with vicar, Revd Beverley Mason.

The format is the same each month:

- Welcome (including refreshments)
- Story and introduction of the theme
- Singing
- Creative / craft activities
- Family Worship
- Tea

We use the church, the hall and the grounds outside if it's a fine day!

How do I join?

Simply turn up on the first Thursday of the month. Tell your friends – the more people who join us, the more fun we all have!

What else do I need to know?

We ask for just £1 per child to cover our costs. Parents / carers must stay with their children and supervise them moving from church to hall and to the toilet etc. We are unable to look after children without your support. Everyone is welcome, come along and come back every month with your friends!
