MOTOR-TRUCKS COLLIDE

WINCHELSEA, Tuesday.

A motor-truck with a trailer attached, owned by Mr. A. Johnson, of Warrnambool, and driven by L. A. Twyman collided with a truck driven by A. Kelly, of Colac, near Moriac, on the Prince's Highway, last night. The trailer of Johnson's truck, which was loaded with empty bottles, overturned and broken glass was strewn along the road for some yards. No one was injured. Twyman and a passenger remained on the road all night directing motorists past the broken glass.
