17th June 1893

A supplementary Government Gazette has been issued placing the new Electoral Act under the administration and control of the Colonial Secretary. Mr. District Court Judge Murray, Mr. Edward Twyman (Chief Surveyor and Director of Trigonometrical Survey), and Mr. George Lewis (District Government Officer) have been appointed Electoral District Commissioners.

The duty of the Commissioners is to make the redistribution of seats, and this redistribution is to take effect after approval by resolution of the Legislative Assembly, and after the proclamation of the boundaries.
