POLICE

Mr. Johnson presided in the Charge Division of the Central Police Court yesterday. Thomas Wade, 15, no occupation, and George Twyman, 14, newsboy, were charged with playing a game, to wit "heading 'em," to the annoyance of passengers in a public place off King-street. The former was fined 10s., levy and distress, or 24 hours' imprisonment, while the later was fined 1s., levy and distress, or one hour's imprisonment.
