

Will of Sarah Twyman

Transcribed from PROB/11/1175 112 by Simon J. Golding, October 2008

In the name of God Amen I Sarah Twyman of the parish of Saint Catherine's near the Tower of London spinster do make, publish and declare this my last Will and Testament in [unreadable] following that is to say first it is my will and desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses shall be fully paid and satisfied and after payment thereof I give and bequeath unto my sister Ann Twyman of Margate in the County of Kent spinster the sum of one hundred pounds for her own use and benefit to be paid within three months after my decease. And I give, devise and bequeath unto my sister Mary Twyman of the parish of Saint Catherine's aforesaid spinster the [unreadable] and remainder of my real and personal estate and effects of what nature or kind soever or wheresoever to hold to and to the only proper use and belief of my said sister Mary Twyman [unreadable] and assigns forever. And I do hereby make, constitute and appoint my said sister Mary Twyman sole executor of this my last Will and Testament and do hereby revoke and make void all former and other wills and bequests by me at any time heretofore made or given and do declare this only to be and contain my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I the said Sarah Twyman leave to this my last Will and Testament contained in one sheet of paper set my hand and seal this second day of May in the Year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty three [the mark of Sarah Twyman] Signed, sealed, published and declared by the said Sarah Twyman the testatrix as and for her last Will and Testament in the presence of us who in her presence at her request and in the presence of each other leave subscribed our names as witnesses hereunto [the mark of Leonard Kilham] [the mark of Wm. Wood] [the mark of Eliz. Hoskins]
