## ***Introduction***

The format used in previous years for this report has been retained as it enables it to be produced more quickly. In this report, only records of taxa deemed to be significant are shown. These include taxa new to the County list and those of conservation importance. Additionally, the new format has allowed the reporting of details of butterfly taxa.

Many recorders have contributed records to the Pembrokeshire Lepidoptera Database during the year. There is not space to list them all but the most significant are listed in Table 1.

Table 2 shows the levels of recording for the various families of Lepidoptera and Table 3 lists a comparison of recording levels with previous years. Table 4 lists the species recorded as new to the County in 2006.

## Recording Levels

In 2008, a total of 10,172 records were added to the County database. These records were of 597 taxa from a total of 40 families. The full details are included in Table 2. Although the total number of records is much lower than last year (17,633) the numbers of taxa and families recorded are up quite considerably from the 2007 totals of 290 taxa and 18 families. A comparison of the numbers of records, taxa and families is given below in Table 3.
