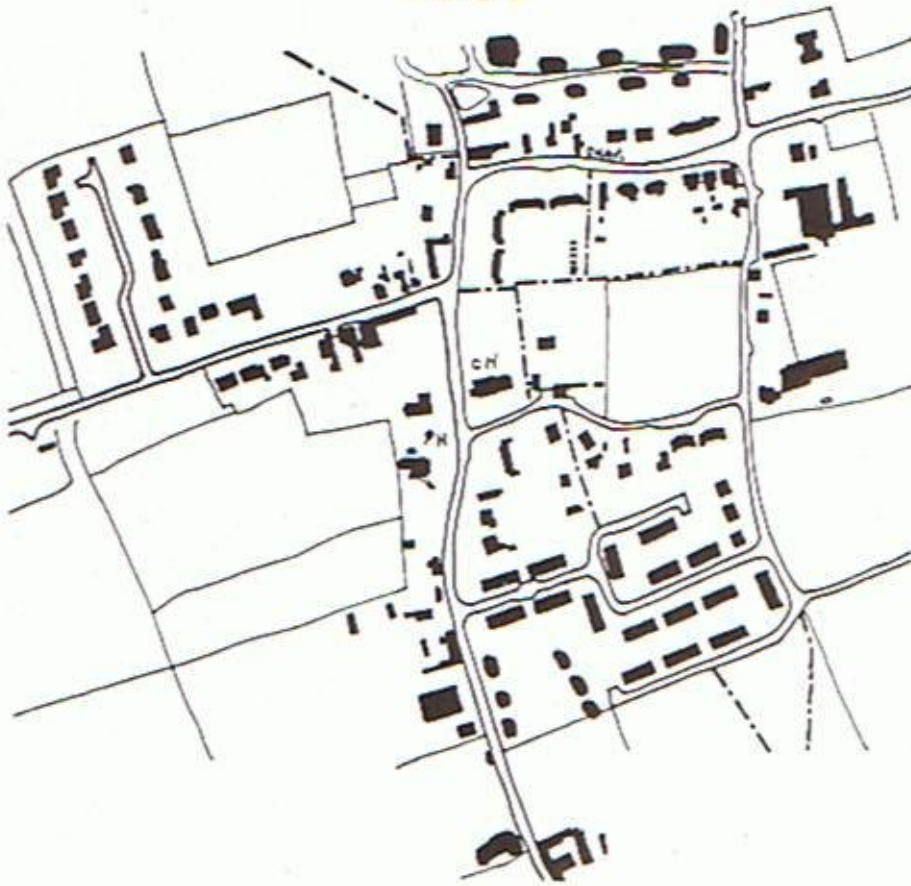


# UPTON PARISH GUIDE & DIRECTORY 1997



With the compliments of the Parish Council

**UPTON** (i.e. the upper enclosed village) is situated 5 miles south-east of Gainsborough in flat open countryside with a total area of 1961 acres.

Village facilities include a Church, Methodist Chapel, Public House, Fish and Chip Shop, Post Office/General Store, Church Hall and a Village Hall which serves both Upton and Kexby. A mobile Library calls at the village once a fortnight.

Upton is served by public transport with weekday services to Gainsborough and Lincoln. Primary school children travel to Lea and those of secondary school age attend schools in Gainsborough and Lincoln.

Local employment and services are provided by a range of activities which include agriculture, electrical, building and joinery contractors, television engineering, agricultural engineering and supplies and custom and vehicle engineering.

An airline service is operated at Sturgate Airfield together with a flying club.

The adult population is 336.

The Parish Church is dedicated to All Saints and contains evidence of Pre-Conquest work in the herring-bone masonry in the North and South walls of the Chancel. The South doorway is of Norman origin. The tower, with a circular west window was re-built in 1767, the older tower having fallen down. The Church was restored by James Fowler in the 1870's. Further restoration work, including the installation of a new electrical heating system has recently been completed. The tower contains six bells, the oldest of which is dated 1641.

The Methodist Chapel was opened for worship in 1822 and is part of the Gainsborough Methodist Circuit.

The Village Inn, The Rosc and Crown, was built in the 1950's replacing one of ancient origin.

During the past years a number of footpaths and rights of way have been re-opened and signposted. These footpaths now provide pleasant walks but care should be taken to shut gates, keep dogs under control and not damage any crops which will ensure that the present excellent relationship with the local farmers continues.
