NERO.

Emperor AD64 - AD68.

Accused the Christians of starting the great fire in Rome in AD64 and launched first of the persecutions. He rebuilt Rome Magnificently.



LAUDAT

TRAJAN.

Emperor AD98 - AD117.

Born in Spain, he was the first non-Italian Emperor. Adopted Hadrian, who he named as his heir.



CONSTANTINE (The Great).

Emperor AD307 - AD337.

Proclaimed Emperor in York (Eboracum). He struggled with rivals until he became undisputed Emperor in Italy and the West in AD312.



CARACALLA.

Emperor AD198 - AD217.

During his reign he extended Roman Citizenship to all free inhabitants of the Empire.



CLAUDIUS.

Emperor AD41 - AD54.

Landed in Britain in AD43 and made it a Province of the Roman Empire.
