May 9th 2009 – The Ultimate Day Out!!!

We are now starting to take bookings for our trip to Alton Towers in May. All the info you need is below, but please note that at this stage, times and costs are approximate. Your £10 deposit will be refundable up until Sunday March 22nd, but after that date we will only be able to offer refunds if we can fill your place with someone else. Please note that in April the cost of tickets for the trip will go up, late bookers will have to pay the extra costs.

The Date: Saturday May 9th 2009. Leave Toton at **8.30 am** to head for Alton Towers Theme Park. We'll return to Toton at approx **10.30 pm** that evening.

What's Involved? We'll arrive in time for you to spend all day on the rides – Nemesis, Air, Ripsaw, Squirrel Nutkin and the rest – before going to the concert arena in the Car Park. As well as top Christian bands such as Kutless and Superchick there'll be side shows, DJ's, graffiti artists and more. It's a music festival in one day!

How Much then? All this for between £30 and £35. (We'll know the exact cost when we know the size of coach we need to book!) The cost covers entry to the park (the rides are free once inside) and the concert, travel and insurance but not food or drink. You'll need to allow for food and drink – you might want to bring sandwiches for at the concert (you'll be able to leave these on the coach) and money to buy lunch in the park for example. There are chip vans at the concert, but they are very expensive.

Who's it for then? The trip is being organised by the Toton Churches, and is open to anyone involved in any of the youth groups run by the churches and in at least Year 7 at school.

What do I need to do then? Stapled to this letter is a booking form – complete it and return it to either Maria Mohr or Andy Glascott as soon as possible, along with your £10 deposit, but no later than Sunday March 22nd. At the end of March, the price for tickets goes up!

The Safety Bit: In April, we'll give you a full health and consent form for the trip. You must complete this before the day. *You won't be allowed go without a completed form!* There will be full First Aid available, and the leaders from the Toton Churches will all be CRB checked in line with our Child Protection Policy.
