RESPECT FOR YOUR ART – YOUR DOBOK

When you enter the dojang, your dobok is the uniform which identifies you as being privileged to be able to train as a student of Tae Kwon-Do. All students should follow these simple rules to respect their art:

1. Your dobok should be good-fitting, clean, ironed and crease free
2. You should enter the dojang wearing your dobok and belt, ready for training.
3. Do not wear your dobok and belt as outdoor clothes. Apart from the risk of getting your dobok dirty, it could be regarded as showing off and an encouragement for violence.
4. If you wish, wear a jacket, track suit, or similar over your dobok without your belt.

GRADING INTERVALS

Please remember:

Grading intervals of 3 months up to blue belt and 6 months thereafter are absolute minimum times.

For this: you must have mastered all the necessary skills up to and including your present grade; **and** have a better than 75% attendance.

The average intervals for juniors are 6 months and 9 months and it is not unusual for these times to extend to over a year.

If you regularly train just once a week, expect the interval to be 2-3 times the minimum.

You only fail when you give up, and your reward for perseverance (one of the tenets of Tae Kwon-Do) is to know that you fully deserve your grade.
